WSH BULLETIN: ENSURING COVID-19 SAFE WORKPLACES

- The new Workplace Safety and Health (COVID-19 Safe Workplace) Regulations 2021 have come into effect on 1 January 2022 with the following requirements:
- ⇒ Allow up to 50% of employees who are able to work from home, to be at the workplace at any point in time
- ⇒ Implement vaccination-differentiated access to the workplace from 1 January 2022.
- ⇒ Establish a system of Safe Management Measures (SMM) to provide a safe and healthy working environment.
